## **Students Cultural Activity with**

## **Japanese Universities and High Schools**

- **Objectives:** aims to provide Japanese programme students with more opportunities to communicate with Japanese people in an out-of-class environment. Upon the requests of some Japanese high schools, our students were invited to serve as student tourist-guides to conduct a student-oriented cultural exploration trip with the Japanese university or high school students who came to Hong Kong on their 'cultural learning field trip'. Students toured around some famous scenic spots with the Japanese students to deepen their understanding of Hong Kong society and the daily life patterns of Hong Kong people.
- In Semester A 2018-2019, there were 6 student cultural activities organized upon the request of the Japanese schools. More than 160 current Year 1 and Year 2 students were invited to join these activities.

**Time:** From 9:00am—16:00pm

Venue: escorted Japanese students visiting local famous cultural, historical and scenic spots in

Hong Kong

• Outcomes: Students were given chances to practise their Japanese oral skills by using Japanese to converse, interact with those Japanese students when touring around Hong Kong. Those who have participated in these cultural exchange activities could exchange their views on differences of outlook of life, academic studies and aspiration of young people with the Japanese students. Participants have become more confident and self-assertive of themselves.
